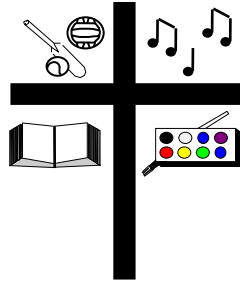

Dear Parents,

Year 3 and 4 Swimming Lessons - Spring Term 2019

We have booked a course of swimming lessons for Years 3 and 4 on Wednesday mornings throughout Spring term, at Sir John Deane's College swimming pool. Swimming and water safety is a requirement of the national P.E. curriculum for all KS2 children in England.

The children will have a total of 11 lessons. The lessons will commence the first week back after the Christmas holidays, on Wednesday 9th January and continue up to the Spring break holidays, with the final lesson on Wednesday 27th March.

Please ensure that your child brings a swimming kit for each lesson.

The children will be accompanied by Miss Porter and will be taught by qualified instructors at the pool.

The school heavily subsidises swimming lessons for all pupils, but it is necessary for us to ask parents for a contribution of £33.00 per child towards the costs of transport, pool hire and instructors. This equates to just £3 per lesson including transport! **I would be grateful if this could be paid no later than by February half term.**

However, we require your consent for us to take your child swimming **prior to the first lesson** and would ask therefore that you complete and return the slip attached **by 7th December**.

I have attached guidelines provided by Sir John Deane's with regards to plasters, asthma, illness, goggles and jewellery. Please read this carefully, paying particular attention to the section regarding illness. Kindly complete and return the slip attached to it, if necessary. Please note that your child **will not** be permitted to wear goggles or jewellery without signed consent from parents.

We would also ask you to note the Cheshire West and Chester guidance, which reflects national guidance, with regards to children swimming and diarrhoea/sickness. This states that children should not use the pool if they have had diarrhoea or sickness for 14 days after experiencing symptoms.
