# **Fundraising Targets and The School Wish List**

So far this school year we have been able to pay for transport and treats for the annual Christmas Panto and also purchase a full set of Hi Vis Vests for school children and staff to use on excursions.

Following on from last years work in the playground, school are keen to continue to improve the outdoor space and as a priority would like to install a pergola to use as an outdoor classroom area, as well as some much needed shade in the summer months.

We are delighted to share that FOCS applied to the CWAC members budget award scheme for funding at the end of January and have been awarded £1750 towards this project making it far more achievable for us - so watch this space!

At Christmas we received a very generous donation of £500 towards books for school, which has allowed us to get started with this project straight away. # Ongoing Fundraising Update
